<u>Days & Hours of Operation:</u> Operation hours are from 5:00 AM until 7:00 PM, Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

<u>Riding Policy:</u> For the safety and consideration of yourself and others...Failure to abide by these rules may result in removal from bus.

- No Eating, Drinking, Smoking or Loud Music
- No Profanity/Racial/Vulgar Comments
- Riding BTD vehicles under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs is prohibited
- · Stand away from curb until the bus is completely stopped.
- Have exact fare ready, drivers do not make change.
- Watch your step getting on and off the bus.
- Use the handrails and sit in a seat as soon as possible.
- Don't let children play or stand on the seats.
- Be courteous to other passengers.
